## RESPONSIBILITIES AND QUALIFICATIONS

Standardized Patients are carefully trained to portray a patient during a mock doctor-patient encounter as part of a high-stakes clinical skills examination. All ages and ethnicities are encouraged to apply, our sites are in need of SPs who can portray ages that range from under 18 to over 65, all applicants must be 18+ to apply. Starting pay is \$20/hour.

### Things you should know about being an SP at NBOME:

- Minimum availability of 12 days per month required.
- Excellent recall and observational skills a must.
- Weekday AM shifts are available, plus some Saturdays.
- A meal is provided during exam sessions.
- No invasive procedures will be performed or experimental medications given.
- Acting background helpful, but not necessary.
